Confirmation of Government Advice for Furloughed Staff

Current advice (published 26th March and last updated 15th April) states:

‘Once you are on furlough you will not be able to work for your employer. You can undertake training or volunteer subject to public health guidance, as long as you’re not:

- *making money for your employer or a company linked or associated to your employer*
- *providing services to your employer or a company linked or associated to your employer’.*

Google’s Digital Garage includes courses focusing on digital marketing, data and time management, plus free-to-attend, upcoming webinars



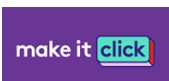
Lloyds Digital Academy is split into two sections, ‘Learn for Life’ and ‘Learn for Business’, and includes courses focusing on a range of subjects
